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NAPLES WINTER WINE FESTIVAL REVEALS THREE AUTOMOBILES AVAILABLE AT 2014 AUCTION

NAPLES, Florida – November 28, 2013 -- The Naples Children & Education Foundation, founder of the Naples Winter Wine Festival, announced three superlative automobiles that will be available at the 2014 event, scheduled for January 24-26 at The Ritz-Carlton Golf Resort, Naples. Two will be sold to the highest bidder at the Saturday auction, while one will be awarded to the winning ticket holder in a raffle on Sunday.

"These cars are show-stoppers," comments Festival Co-chair Adria Starkey. "We truly appreciate the generosity of the donors and the efforts of our trustees in making them available to us. They surely will contribute greatly to the success of our event, and ultimately to our mission of improving the lives of underserved and at-risk children in Collier County."

2014 Rolls-Royce Wraith

The 2014 Rolls-Royce Wraith, which was unveiled in Naples, Florida on November 11, 2013, will be sold to the highest bidder at the 2014 Naples Winter Wine Festival. The Wraith has sold out in 2013 and the current waiting period to secure one of these remarkable automobiles outside of the auction is 4 to 6 months.

Wraith is the boldest, most dramatic and powerful Rolls-Royce that has played host to the famous Spirit of Ecstasy figurine. Featuring a contemporary two-door design, Wraith's striking fastback body exudes power, style and drama.

At 624 horsepower, the Wraith also is the most powerful Rolls-Royce motor car ever made. It boasts a twin-turbo V12 engine married to 8-speed automatic ZF transmission, and achieves the 0-62 mph sprint in 4.6 seconds.

The Wraith is finished in Diamond Black to complement the sweeping fastback design that gives the car its unique character. Bold lines, tension in the panels and a raked rear screen evoke the image of a world-class athlete poised in the starting blocks.

Coach doors open to reveal a sumptuous interior complete with the softest Phantom-grade leathers in moccasin with black piping and expanses of Tudor Oak wood to cosset four occupants in a space bathed in light and warmth.

As has been the case for more than a century, a Rolls-Royce motor car has featured technologies designed to support occupants discreetly, delivering a peerless driving experience epitomized by the term "effortlessness."

About Rolls-Royce

Since 1904, Rolls-Royce has created instantly recognizable motor cars that have made the company an enduring icon all over the world, representing the pinnacle in luxury motor vehicles. 2013 marks the 10 year anniversary of the modern Rolls-Royce Motor Cars as part of BMW Group [first Phantom rolled off the line on Jan. 1st, 2003]. Each vehicle is hand-made to the exact specifications of the customer, in the company's manufacturing plant at its home on the Goodwood Estate in Chichester, England. The current family of Rolls-Royce motor cars includes the innovative Phantom, Phantom Extended Wheelbase, Phantom Coupé, and Phantom Drophead Coupé; the technologically advanced Ghost and Ghost Extended Wheelbase; and the groundbreaking Wraith, arriving in showrooms in the fall of 2013. Lamborghini 50th Anniversary Aventador Roadster

This extremely limited edition Lamborghini, also offered at auction at the Festival, boasts a removable top, gull-wing doors and a top speed of 217 mph. It is being produced in a worldwide quantity of only 100, of which only 20 will be released in the United States; the auction automobile is numbered 45 out of 100. A model such as this is virtually unattainable, except to a few of Lamborghini's very loyal clients.

With permanent all-wheel drive and output of 720 horsepower, the 6.5-liter twelve-cylinder is 20 hp more powerful than the current V12. This is due to a new specific engine calibration. With its extremely fast-shifting ISR transmission, it accelerates from 0-62 mph in 2.9 seconds. Compared to its predecessor, it offers an increase of more than 50% in aerodynamic efficiency.

This Roadster features an all-new and exclusive color called Giallo Maggio (May Yellow), which incorporates a particularly intense glitter effect. The color is not only a tribute to the most preferred color of Lamborghini drivers, but also a reference to the founding of Automobili Lamborghini in May 1963. The front, rear and sills have a two-tone Giallo Maggio/matte black finish that emphasizes the automobile's streamlined shape.

The interior is upholstered in fine, natural, semi-aniline leather developed for this model, in colors inspired by Lamborghini's home in the Italian region of Emilia-Romagna. Each has a forged composite badge with the 50th anniversary logo and a serial number.

In addition to the car, the Lamborghini package includes access to the inaugural US event for the Lamborghini Esperienza program, a full day of driving instruction engineered by Lamborghini's factory drivers, at Palm Beach International Raceway for 1 person. Available dates are Tuesday March 26 – Friday March 29, 2014.

Maserati GranTurismo Convertible Sport

In 2010, Maserati introduced the first four-seat convertible in the company's 97 year history: the GranTurismo Convertible, an immensely solid and spacious machine - with 4.7 liters of V-8 power and a high level of equipment. Given intense customer interest in an even more sport-oriented version –Maserati created the GranTurismo Convertible Sport.

The performance and driving dynamics of the Convertible Sport are enhanced through major upgrades to everything that touches the driver. From the changes to the standard adaptive Sport Skyhook suspension, to the MC Shift 6 speed automatic transmission with rev-matched downshifting heard via the sport exhaust system and aerodynamic-improving exterior changes, the GT Convertible Sport offers the sharpest performing version convertible for the driving enthusiast with the ability for three passengers to partake in the excitement.

The new Convertible Sport is equipped with a 454 HP engine with a top speed of 177 mph and a 0-60 time of 4.9 seconds. The latest Maserati sport exhaust system, as found on the GranTurismo S, producing a free-flowing sport sound that stirs the soul is a

natural for this model. Also, as found on the GranTurismo S model – the Convertible Sport will be delivered with a new front aerodynamic fascia, side skirts and dark look trim and headlamps, as well as body-colored door handles.

A ticket for the drawing is a suggested minimum donation of \$3,000, or two for \$5,000. Raffle tickets are available prior to the festival by calling the NWWF office at 1-888-837-4919. No more than 300 tickets will be issued, and the ticket holder need not be present at the festival's Sunday celebration brunch when the raffle winner is announced.

The GranTurismo Sport convertible was publically unveiled at this year's Geneva Motor Show. It combines an upgraded 4.7-litre, V8 engine with a 10 horsepower increase to 450 horsepower and improved fuel economy with the faster MC Auto Shift transmission.

With a 176 mph top speed and a 0-60 mph sprint of just 5.3 seconds, the GranTurismo Sport convertible is brimming with performance and luxury refinements both inside the cabin and underneath its award-winning body panels.

Its six-speed transmission includes a super-fast MC Auto Shift mode and has been developed for the GranTurismo Sport convertible directly from the transmission in the Quattroporte Sport GT S. The handling has been enhanced for greater speed too, with an upgrade and revision of the Skyhook active-suspension system and the adoption of a more-responsive brake package.

Visually, the GranTurismo Sport convertible is characterized by a more-pronounced dynamic look. This look begins with the GranTurismo convertible's distinctive nose and continues with a host of small, perfectly integrated changes throughout the body and the interior. The Maserati offered here boasts a red exterior, tan interior and black wheels.

The festival highlight takes place at The Ritz-Carlton Golf Resort, Naples – a founding sponsor of the festival – with a culinary showcase and live auction of more than 60 lots. A wine-down party that evening and brunch the next day bring festivities to a close.
