The pairing of chefs and vintners for the exclusive annual Naples Winter Wine Festival, announced Tuesday, could stir up an appetite among food and wine lovers of all persuasions. This year, vintners who will provide for its exclusive Friday dinners include names from Spain and Uruguay as well as France, Italy and the United States.

Among them are Argentina-born Francis Mallman, considered the authority on Patagonian fire cooking and who added El Fuego by Francis Mallman in Miami to his list of restaurants last year, as well as David Kinch, whose California restaurant, Manresa, just won its third Michelin star. The chef de cuisine, the festival's honored chef, previously announced, will be Wolfgang Puck.

"We have, I think, one of the most exciting lineups ever for chefs and vintners," said Jeff Gargiulo, one of the cochairs for the Jan. 27-29 festival. "It's from both the breadth and the depth. I think we've got a diverse group of chefs and cuisines and vintners from many different places in world."

"The fact these wineries and the people of these wineries and the chefs come here to help out children is pretty amazing and gratifying," he said.

Next, of course, is the challenge of chefs and vintners, some of them countries away from each other, collaborating on their particular dinner.

The Naples Winter Wine Festival, founded in 2001, has raised more than \$146 million for its grant-making organization, the Naples Children & Education Foundation. The foundation has awarded grants to more than 40 nonprofit organizations and estimates it has impacted the lives of more than 200,000 children.
