Vintage Corvette and new Ferrari to drive auction bids at 2011 Naples Winter Wine Festival 2011 Lexus IS 350 Hardtop Convertible F-Sport to be raffled

A 1956 Corvette Convertible and 2011 Ferrari 458 Italia sports coupe are being auctioned along with fine wine lots, once-in-a-lifetime experiences and other luxuries. The raffle prize at the festival, which benefits underprivileged and at-risk children through the Naples Children & Education Foundation, is a 2011 Lexus IS 350 Hardtop Convertible F-Sport.

2011 Ferrari 458 Italia sports coupe auction lot

Named "Car of the Year" by BBC's Top Gear Magazine and dubbed "the new sports car benchmark" by Britain's Autocar magazine, the 2011 Ferrari 458 Italia has shined brightly in tough test drives on both road and track.

Thanks to a new 4,500cc V8 engine that punches out 570 horsepower, the two-seater 458 Italia boasts an extraordinary power-weight ratio, allowing it to sprint from 0 to 60 mph in under 3.4 seconds and hit a maximum speed of 202 mph. It delivers superb vehicle dynamics with an ideal weight balance for a sports car with a mid-rear engine – 42 percent front, 58 percent rear. The electronic control systems also help guarantee maximum performance in all driving conditions. Its new suspension setup is tuned for ultimate road holding and superlative handling. This ensures the 458 Italia is extremely responsive and maintains superior ride comfort. The interior is purely focused on the driver, with new steering wheel and dash layout coming directly from racing practice.

The Naples Winter Wine Festival was founded in 2001 and is hosted annually by NCEF trustees. Festival proceeds have helped nearly 100,000 children through grants to children's charities and collaborative funding of major projects including a pediatric dental center and early learning center. The festival is ranked by Wine Spectator as the most successful charity wine auction in the nation since 2004 and a top 10 event for wealthy Americans by the Luxury Institute.
