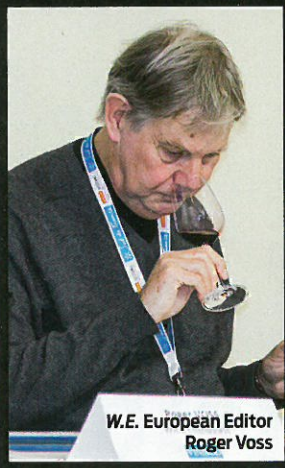


SOUTHERN CHARM
