



2019 NAPLES WINTER WINE FESTIVAL SET TO BRING JOY TO THE WORLD

Annual star-studded festival is ready to dazzle Naples, Florida with three days of unprecedented culinary and wine experiences

January 22, 2019 (Naples, FL) — Excitement is building in Southwest Florida as the highly anticipated 19th annual Naples Winter Wine Festival (NWWF) is only a few days away. This year's theme, "Joy to the World," will bring some of the world's most renowned vintners, chefs and Master Sommeliers together for three days of rare vintage wines, unforgettable culinary experiences and highly coveted auction lots.

The Naples Winter Wine Festival is the most successful international charity wine auction, having raised \$176 million to date since its inception in 2001 and \$15.1 million from last year's event alone. Beginning next Thursday, the Festival will welcome 18 celebrity chefs, over 30 world-class vintners from the top wineries around the globe and 18 of the world's elite Master Sommeliers, who will team up to provide guests with exquisite food and wine offerings. NWWF will also showcase over 60 unparalleled auction lot items available for bidding during Saturday's iconic Live Auction.

This year's auction lot items will feature exclusive experiences and one-of-a-kind prizes. Bidders will have their eye on an incredibly rare and unique collection of eight Double Magnums of Screaming Eagle Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon, one from each year between 1992 to 1999. One couple will win an ultimate getaway to the U.S. Virgin Islands on a newly refurbished yacht and an individually tailored itinerary, while car-enthusiasts can raise their paddle for a 2019 McLaren 720S Spider convertible or a 2020 Bentley Continental GT Convertible.
