

2020 NAPLES WINTER WINE FESTIVAL ANNOUNCES OPENING OF ONLINE AUCTION

Unrivaled travel, wine and culinary experiences are now available to bidders outside of the NWWF live auction

January 21, 2020 (NAPLES, FL) - Ahead of the highly anticipated 20th Anniversary of the Naples Winter Wine Festival (NWWF), the Festival has announced the opening of its 2020 online auction. Available now, the items up for bid include remarkable experiences in travel, food and wine in Naples, Florida and around the world.

Since its launch in 2015, the NWWF online auction has provided additional participation opportunities to the local community, as well as bidders and supporters nationwide, who may not be able to attend the live auction during the Festival. Since its inception, the online auction has raised over \$1 million to benefit underprivileged at-risk children of Collier County.

- A Live Arts Naples Experience for 12 people The winning bidder of this lot will be able to experience a unique version of performance art, headlined by famed country artist Billy Dean and top local musical talent. This will be followed by a lesson in pasta making for two, and dinner for four at Monteverde with wine pairings.
- A Private Whiskey Tasting and Dinner at The Grill Bar at The Ritz-Carlton, Naples -Four people will visit the luxurious Ritz-Carlton, Naples, which has become famous for its innovative dining.
