A native of Michigan, Connelly graduated from Western Michigan University where he began his philanthropy career in 1987 as Assistant Director of Alumni Relations. He later worked at the Indiana University Kelley School of Business as Director of Corporate and Foundation Relations.

Connelly currently serves on the board of Collier-Lee Chapter of The Association of Fundraising Professionals, which honored him in 2018 with its "Outstanding Fundraising Executive of the Year" award. He also is a member of the Estate Planning Council of Naples and a graduate of Leadership Collier. Connelly became a Certified Fund-Raising Executive (CFRE) in 2018.
