

2022 NAPLES WINTER WINE FESTIVAL TO HONOR LEGACY VINTNERS FOR THEIR YEARS OF CONTRIBUTIONS TOWARD THE ANNUAL CHARITY WINE AUCTION

NAPLES, FL (December 17, 2021) - The Naples Winter Wine Festival (NWWF) announced that this year's event will celebrate nearly a dozen long-time Legacy Vintners who have contributed so much toward the success of the NWWF since the event's inception in 2001. With the theme "Rise Up: Twenty Twenty Twogether," the NWWF will return to The Ritz-Carlton Golf Resort, Naples highlighting the finest food, wine and incredible live auction lots on January 28-30, 2022.

The NWWF will mark its 22nd anniversary, impacting more than 50 of the most effective nonprofit organizations in the local community and providing more than 275,000 at-risk and underprivileged children with the essential services and resources they need to excel.
