NAPLES WINE COLLECTOR'S PRIZED CELLAR TO BE AUCTIONED TO BENEFIT THE NAPLES CHILDREN & EDUCATION FOUNDATION AND NASHVILLE WINE AUCTION

The Nunnelly Collection will be Sold with Global Wine House Acker on May 17-18

NAPLES, FL – May 5, 2023 – The wine collection of a beloved local Naples wine collector will be auctioned with global wine auction house, <u>Acker</u>, on Wednesday and Thursday, May 17-18, 2023, with net proceeds dedicated to the <u>Naples Children & Education Foundation</u> and the Nashville Wine Auction for cancer research.

Bill Nunnelly, philanthropist, entrepreneur and active member of the Naples community, dedicated his wine collection to the charities before his passing in February 2022. He and his surviving wife, Rosann, were each decades-long members of the organizations, and frequent attendees at food and wine tasting events all over the country which advocated for the betterment of their communities.

The two-day <u>auction</u> offering the Nunnelly Collection is being conducted by Acker, the largest fine wine and spirits auction house in the world and the oldest wine merchant in America. Nunnelly's lots are a featured collection in the sale, alongside other tremendous offerings of top Burgundy, Bordeaux, cult California, and other highly sought regions of the wine world.

Comprised of nearly 75 lots, the collection features rare gems including Bordeaux's 1990 Chateau Haut Brion, 1989 La Mission Haut Brion, and magnums of 1982, 1986, and 1990 Chateau Lafite Rothschild. More exceptional 1982 Bordeaux include Chateaux Latour, Mouton, Gruaud Larose, Calon Segur, Leoville Poyferre, Ducru Beaucaillou, and Leoville Las Cases, plus lauded Burgundy Domaine J.F. Mugnier 1999, 2002, 2005, and 2010 Musigny, and 1999 Chambolle Musigny Les Amoureuses. Each lot in the collection, which also includes choice selections from Champagne, France's Rhone Valley, Italy, and California, represent the best from their respective regions from a lifetime well-spent collecting the world's finest wines.
