With three days of activities, the NWWF showcases dozens of award-winning chefs and renowned vintners who generously donate their time and talents at intimate wine dinners across Naples, plus an incredible live auction with one-of-a-kind auction lots. The 2025 NWWF raised a record of over \$34 million toward NCEF's mission of transforming the lives of children in need.

The theme challenges Festival supporters, vintners, chefs and donors to picture the impact their generosity can have in creating a world of endless futures for children in our community.

Ticket packages for the Naples Winter Wine Festival are sold for the entire weekend and start at \$17,500 per couple for a Double Magnum package and \$40,000 for two couples to experience a Jeroboam package.
